CCO MISSIONARY APPEAL

Meet Matthew Tadgell and Elyse Hannouche, Catholic youth in Peterborough. Both are students at Trent University and both received exciting news that were chosen to go on international mission trips to Honduras and Ireland alongside Catholic Christian Outreach (CCO). CCO is a Canadian university student movement dedicated to evangelizing students and encouraging them to be leaders in the renewal of the world.

Matthew has the opportunity to reach students in the cities of Comayagua and Tegucigalpa. He will be helping build campus ministries, as well as reaching students who have never heard the Gospel. Supporting Matthew's mission will provide an opportunity and a space for students in Honduras to live out their faith on campus, as well as providing Matthew with valuable experience to help students in Peterborough encounter Jesus in their own lives.

Elyse will be going to Ireland, and will be assisting multiple parishes in Donegal and Waterford, training the next generation of Catholic leaders in evangelizing, as well as leading their ongoing Catholic revival. Ireland was once one of the most Catholic countries in the world, but they have rapidly become one of the most secular. Many Churches are closing, and there are few priests left to serve the small number of parishioners. However, the hope of the mission is to bring the fullness of the Catholic faith to people who have never truly experienced God's love.

In order to provide for the needs of the mission, Elyse and Matthew are invited to collect donations. CCO is a charity, and relies on the generosity of Catholics nationwide. We ask for your prayerful consideration in donating, as well as your prayers for the success of the mission.
